AGFA member Andy Bennett participated in a military timeline event sponsored by the Oklahoma History Center in Oklahoma City, OK. The event was designed to educate the public about military history through time.

The AGFA display was set up in conjunction with the WWII Airborne Demonstration Team display (Bennett is also a member of this organization). While the WWII ADT display focused on airborne history, the AGFA displays were oriented toward Coast Artillery Corps, Signal Corps, and early WWII uniforms and equipment.

Items on display included 90mm anti-aircraft rounds, a BD-72 field switchboard, EE-8A field telephones, weapons including the 1903 Springfield and 1911A1 pistol, an M1910A1 azimuth instrument, and a range of early war uniforms.
